

# MENTORING PROGRAM FOR NEW FACULTY MEMBERS

The executive vice president and provost and the deans of each college provide funds to support a mentoring program for newly appointed faculty. Faculty members may each receive up to \$1,500 designated for a project that engages at least one mentor, over time, to advance their academic career.

The project should represent a career development opportunity that may not otherwise be possible without this funding. The intent is for the mentoring project to be one aspect of a comprehensive mentoring program that is sustained across the pre-tenure years.

- > tenure-track assistant professors
- > clinical assistant professors
- > assistant professors of practice
- > collegiate assistant professors
- > University Libraries assistant professors (continued appointment-track)
