### **VIRGINIA TECH PUBLISHING**

Leading innovation and access

Summary of works since 2017

Virginia Tech Publishing started in 2017 but its history is rooted in a much deeper tradition. In 1989, the Scholarly Communication Project was established in Newman Library as a place to experiment with technology to produce online scholarship in new and developing formats. In 2013-2014, Virginia Tech played a leading role in advancing the idea of a community dedicated to the field of library publishing, which resulted in the creation of the Library Publishing Coalition. In the years since, the Library has continued to embrace the increasingly diverse products of research and scholarship, especially those that are more than just a paper version published online, including e-journals, interactive books, open educational resources, innovative digital projects, and audio

View Project

The American Soldier project led by Professor Ed Gitre in the Department of History allows users to browse and search over 65,000 pages of uncensored, open-ended responses handwritten by servicemembers, view and download survey data and original analyses, read topical essays by leading historians, and access additional learning resources. The project began in 2015, in 2017 it received a National Endowment for the Humanities Division of Preservation and Access planning grant, and a second implementation NEH grant in 2019. The project launched in 2021 with support from many collaborators, including Virginia Tech University Libraries and Virginia Tech Publishing.

- How can we assess the broader impacts of my NSF grant?
- Why do lemurs eat dirt?
- What methods work best to help students in college Spanish classes learn the gender of irregular nouns?
- Which employees are most likely to be hired and retained?
- What is the repeatability and reproducibility of a1C (glucose) measurements from home meters?
- Which sequence and amounts of fertilizer will lead to higher crop yield?
- Which genotype of what amounts mosquitoes is more likely to successfully mate?
- Are underrepresented or majority engineering students more likely to participate in various activities?
- What are the underlying features that lead to pursuing a career in the construction industry?
- Is the laboratory staining test accurate for predicting genetic mutations associated with glioblastoma?



Mastery: Demonstrates a teaching selfawareness, reinvent courses and learning activities building on learning success, innovates and shares innovation and learning with others

Proficiency: connects course with curriculum, integrated more advanced pedagogical methods, analyzes student learning formatively and makes real-time adjustments, differentiates instruction, engages in reflective practice
