### INTRODUCTION

Virginia Tech faculty are located through the Commonwealth of Virginia, including 109 Cooperative Extension offices and 11 Agricultural Research and Extension Centers, Commonwealth Campus Centers in Abingdon, Newport News, Richmond, and Roanoke, and the Institute for Advanced Computing in Alexandria. Faculty Affairs is committed to supporting Virginia Tech faculty no matter their location.

### DUAL CAREER PROGRAM

Virginia Tech recognizes that meeting the needs of today's professional couples is a key factor in recruiting and retaining new faculty members. ### CAREGIVING

#### Caregiving Resources at Virginia Tech:

Virginia Tech full-time faculty/staff and non-student wage employees across all locations have unlimited, premium access to the Care.com network for finding childcare, adult care, pet care, housekeeping, and tutoring. You can book short- and long-term care, with a wide range of provider types including those with experience assisting children and adults with special needs.

<u>Child Care Aware of Virginia</u> is an additional resource to find current childcare availability across Virginia.

Virginia Tech has a partnership with <u>Cultural Care Au Pair</u>, providing employees with a \$500 discount as a new family. Among the many benefits to having a live-in care provider, an au pair can help with drop-off and pick-up, coverage for sick days and snow days, and provide the opportunity for better work/life integration for parents.

## NEW FACULTY MENTORING GRANT PROGRAM

Faculty members in their first year in their role at Virginia Tech, no matter the location, may each receive up to \$1,500 designated for a project that engages at least one mentor, over time, to advance their academic career. The project should represent a career development opportunity that may not otherwise be possible without this grant.

### FACULTY WRITING SUPPORT

Faculty Affairs helps faculty writers create effective, sustainable writing practices through grant support, retreats, and workshops. 5 Writing Group Grants are given each year to encourage faculty to form collaborative support networks across departments and colleges. Faculty Affairs also hosts Writing Retreats throughout the year, in both virtual and in-person formats. Retreats usually alternate between Guided and Write-on-Site retreats. Additional workshops on writing related topics are also held throughout the year.

Virginia Cooperative Extension, a partnership between Virginia Tech and Virginia State University, operates out of 107 offices, 11 Agricultural Research and Extension centers, and six 4-H centers across the commonwealth. Extension employs tenure-track faculty in specialist positions that typically also include appointment in an academic department at Virginia Tech. Extension agents are non-tenure-track, administration and professional faculty, who are usually assigned to one of our 108 offices.

The VCE state office and the field offices have a staff to support the activities and goals of Extension.
